Minimization of Plastics Usage Policy

Brainware University is committed to protecting the environment by minimizing the use of plastic in the campus. University recognizes that waste plastics pose a global threat to environment and is working on minimizing the use of plastics, to reduce the environmental impact of waste plastics.

University has made a guideline

to use only those plastic products that can be easily reused or recycled

- Encourage innovative recycling opportunities for the plastic waste in buildings, food courts and daily operations
- Working for development of capability and capacity for recycling plastic waste
- Maintain housekeeping standards at campus to attend to plastic litter
- Work with employees, customers and suppliers to encourage them to take practical steps to reduce the use of plastic and the production of plastic waste
- Expand campaign by NSS volunteers to highlight the environmental damage caused by plastic waste
- Research Work to meet these policy objectives.
- Plastic Hazard Awareness program as a part outreach activity

Standards and operating procedures for the safe handling storage and disposal of waste

University should ensure that all waste generated on its premises is managed in such a manner that it does not endanger the health of people or pollute the environment by implementing the following principles,

- avoid and reduce,
- reuse,
- recycle,
- recovery treatment
- disposal.
